Updates on a third printed publication for Eureka are currently being done.

The first publication, entitled "Explore the Possibilities" is a general overview of Eureka. That has been completed, and is available to anyone who wants it.

The second publication is "Eureka Resources". It is handy for people new to the community because it lists not only services, but also has names and phone numbers to steer those seeking information in the right direction. Even long-time citizens find it to be a useful listing of commonly needed services. This is in its final draft. It will be printed and available within a couple of weeks.

The third publication is a Community Data publication for Eureka. It contains statistics and demographics specifically about Eureka. Some of the main sections are Education, Medical, and Telecommunications. Work is just beginning on updates for this publication and it will be in print in about a month.

Kaitlyn Martinez is doing all the design work for all 3 publications. When she has them completed, she emails them to the Eureka Community Development Company office where they are printed. Volunteers then fold them, and the brochures are then distributed to locations that wish to have them available to the public.

As changes are needed in any of the written materials, Kaitlyn makes the updates and the new information is printed. This has proven to be cost effective since only the number of materials needed is printed. Outdated material is kept to a minimum since it is replaced within a short amount of time – in the past updates were made every few years when a printing company was hired to do the work.

Anyone who spots errors or outdated information on any of the Eureka publications is asked to contact the Eureka Development office so corrections and updates can be made.
