The community based trainings, seminars, and workshops mentioned in a previous column are being identified and details are being worked out to get them on a schedule over the next year. Your input would be greatly appreciated if there is a specific topic you would like to see addressed during that time.

Ones that will happen are the Dave Ramsey 9-session financial course entitled Financial Peace University. This was done last year and requests by people who know about the course have asked for it to be repeated this year. Another requested topic is Hospitality Training and that will be one that will happen. A Job Fair is being currently set up for late November.

Two that will be put on the schedule when facilitators are found are Parliamentary Procedure, which is basically how to effectively run a meeting, and Succession Training, which is the legalities of passing a farm or business from one generation to the next.

Other possibilities are basic computer classes for those who want to start with how to turn on a computer and learning very basic things on a computer; a gathering for new people to the community to meet each other; and an "organization night" where organizations can explain their purpose and community members learn about the opportunities.
