A program is available through GROW South Dakota that assists qualified homeowners whose houses need some fixing-up. Homes in the Eureka area are in the region that they serve.

They can help update worn shingles, siding or make other repairs. This is through a forgivable home improvement loan.

How does a forgivable loan work? The first step is to apply for funds to make improvements to a permanent residence by calling 605-698-7654 Ext. 126 or apply online at [www.growsd.org](http://www.growsd.org). The second step is that, if approved, GROW South Dakota will make repairs to the home. The third part of the loan is that in five years, the loan is totally forgiven. No money needs to be repaid. Each month the house is occupied, 1/60 of the loan is forgiven.
