Those involved in Action Planning groups met to give updates on what has been done so far and laid out plans for upcoming weeks. They will continue to have these types of meetings.

The Recruitment group has met with many of the businesses in Eureka, and will continue to meet with those that have not yet been contacted. The same questions were asked of all businesses. One of the main areas of interest is workforce needs, both for the present and in the future. When that information is collected it will be turned over to the Eureka Community Development Company and job fairs in ND and SD will be attended to try to recruit the employees that are needed in Eureka. Since employees will continue to retire, the need for replacements will remain a constant need. The Recruitment group is not a long term committee and once their fact finding is completed their mission will be done.

The Golden Rule and Involvement groups have contacted other individuals to help them. They are in the process of contacting specific services available to the community and will invite some to the next Action Planning meeting to determine how help can be given.

One major topic that was discussed is the extreme need for housing in Eureka, especially larger homes for rent and sale. Since a great number of regional towns have this problem they will be contacted to see how they have addressed the problem.
