Bresson wrote, “I wanted to pass along information on Rural Development’s REAP program – energy grants for farmers, ranchers, and small businesses to either make energy efficiency improvements (i.e., lighting or heating replacements, grain dryers, etc.) or to install a renewable energy system (i.e., wind, solar, geothermal, etc) in their operation. There will be a national webinar on Feb. 6th from noon to 2:00 pm, CST.

This is one of the few programs that had increased funding from Congress, so I’m hoping to see a good number of grants funded this year in South Dakota, but our farmers, ranchers, and small businesses need to know about the program to apply. Please help to get the word out and **feel free to hand out my contact information!**

If you have a few businesses who may be interested, I’d be glad to make arrangements to come to your community and meet with them.

This is one of the few programs that Congress increased funding for, and we have a sizable allocation in South Dakota. We’d like to see our local people get these grants.
