The Welcome Bag project is one way that the Eureka Community Development Company works with all local businesses and organizations that wish to participate. It is a low-cost way to attract new customers and new members.

Welcome Bags are delivered to people new to the community. Businesses and organizations provide any printed or promotional items they wish to include. This bag of information gives the newcomers an insight into the community and the goods and services that are available locally. By putting the information directly into the prospective new customers' hands they are able to easily learn about local opportunities.

Board members contact businesses whenever a new batch of bags is needed. After items have been collected they are put into canvas bags provided by Eureka Development, and delivered to the new Eureka residents.

There is no cost to any business or organization to have their items included.

If you want to have business cards, pamphlets, coupons, or promotional items included, drop off enough for 20 bags at the Information Center within the next week.

Also, if anyone knows of someone new to Eureka, contact the Eureka Development office so a Welcome Bag can be delivered.
