There are several that work with the Eureka Community Development Company, either as a partner or as a referral.

NECOG-DC (Northeast Council of Governments Development Corporation), GROW South Dakota/NESDEC (Northeast South Dakota Economic Corporation), and REED (Rural Electric Economic Development) are all sources that serve our area. Local participation is a part of each financial deal because all require that the business partners with a bank, and they also often partner with a local economic development group that has a Revolving Loan Fund.

These organizations can provide loans from a few hundred dollars (Eureka Community Development loan fund) to millions of dollars from the other lenders for extremely big projects.

Financing can be for a wide range of projects including business, agri-business, infrastructure, housing, and community development.
