Day Break continued with work for the Stearns Company (life vests), Medipro hot and cold compresses, pillows for Dakotah, and igniter bags for the federal government. An ongoing project was to turn the old Lutheran Home into an Adolescent Treatment facility. Many hours over several years were spent on these two projects to bring jobs to Eureka. Although much time and effort was put into the Adolescent Treatment facility it never did become a reality.

Businesses that were in contact with ECDC were Mid-Prairie Livestock Supplements which produced a molasses supplement, a goat processing company, Super 8 reservations department, and a chiropractor.

Tourism efforts were made through advertising for Eureka in the SD Vacation Guide with costs shared by several organizations, inserts in the Aberdeen News, and special edition newspapers placed in SD rest stops.

Roland Dolly from the state economic development department was the main speaker at the annual meeting – he later died along with Gov. Michelson and others in a plane crash.
